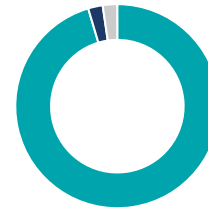

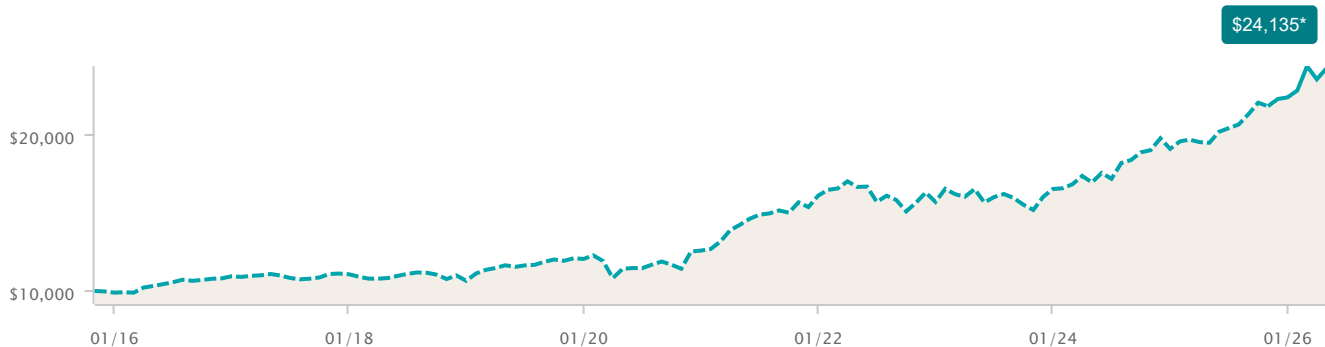
Geographic Allocation (%)
